**MCI/MPS**—Dave reported for Dan that he has the tags that Chad Marsh sent him. Unfortunately Dan is in Burns on a conflagration and will give a presentation during the next meeting.

**Old Business**

1. **Zoll**—Dr. Gruzd is on the committee and asked that SCMC issue check to ECEMS for \$17,000 to pay for the upgrade. Jon Cloutier advised that zoll is currently between technologies and in the near future a better way will appear.
2. **Deschutes County 911**—Tom presented the group with the 33 run card. This card covers convalescent transfers, and will better triage transfers for departments.
3. **SCMC Meeting**—Tom informed the group that a meeting was recently held to air some issues between prehospital folks and ED staff. Several issues were discussed at length.
  1. **EMS Room**—The room should be monitored by everyone and cleaned up after use.
  2. **Juice and Crackers**—No longer should EMS procure these items from the ED. They are for patient use only.
  3. **Staging**—EMS will no longer ‘stage’ on the tarmac outside the ER. The patient will be moved inside so the ambulance can be cleaned while a bed is secured for the patient.
  4. **Language**—EMS providers were reminded to be careful of what is said in the EMS room since patient rooms are very close.
4. **Aeromedical**—Agencies were reminded to call the receiving hospital and give a hear report on your findings and treatment for the patient.
5. **ASA**—Tom reported that the ASA franchise is due next year. Need Deschutes County Agencies to prepare their maps outlining the 8 minute response area’s of each station.
