**LaPine Fire District**—Mike reported they are looking at ambulances for FY-05-06, they are using the 10-10 system, which is working well. The Fire District had two snow rescues over the holidays, which both went well.

**Bend Fire and Rescue**—Tom reported that Bend is looking into a full-time convalescent ambulance. Bend is also looking at replacing 5 ambulances and adding one more to the fleet.

**Sisters Camp Sherman Fire**—Ken reported they had a recruit class for their new employee, Dave Wheeler now working days, they are looking at new ambulances and a new Headquarters Station.

**Redmond Fire and Rescue**—Steve reported a new Horton ambulance to be delivered any day. Current ambulance in Terrebonne is going to the shop for paint and then moved to backup status.

**Black Butte Ranch Rural Fire Protection District**—Pursuing dedicated LZ for Air Life, looking at placement of a training facility.

**Warm Springs Fire**—Dusty reported they have ordered 2 new Braun ambulances, delivery in the middle of March.

**Air Life**—No Report

**Crook County Fire and Rescue**—Jim reported the received \$367,000 in FEMA dollars for station improvements. CCF&R has ordered one new Braun ambulance, expecting delivery in February.

**Jefferson County EMS**—Mike Lepin reported that they are purchasing a Horton ambulance from WSFS, and possibly a new one in FY 05-06. George is doing well. He is back on line. They will be hosting a class regarding surviving hostile environments in May, all are invited to attend.

**Mt. Bachelor**—Rick reported they had a very busy Christmas season, 8,000-11,000 people/day. On January 5,6-7 they will be hosting a World Cup Event. EMT-P students have been a big help. Rick reported that they had a chair evacuation, which 81 people had to be removed from one lift, all went well.
