Approval of Previous Minutes: Dan made the motion to accept the March 2007 Meeting minutes as typed, Tom 2nd, motion passed.

Communication Report—Tom talked about a dislocation reduction protocol. Tom found that the BME doesn't have reduction protocols. However in the May 2006 meeting of the BME made a ruling that in mountain wilderness may be permitted (AMR RAT TEAM). Bend will do more research.

Treasures Report—Tom reported not a lot of business. Received a check from CCFR for 396.00. Getting interest from money market account is in. Patty (RFR) advised that we are getting low on the transfer forms. Jim is going to stop in and talk to the printer about information on the forms.

Committee Reports

Education—Paula reported that interviews are still going. A change to the intro to EMS class to make it more in line with state requirements.

Protocols—Dave is on vacation, however the group discussed if reduction of a dislocated joint was in the scope of practice. Jon directed the group to AMR's RAT team, somehow, even though not in the scope of practice are allowed to reduce dislocated joints. Also the question was asked if CPAP was in the BLS/ILS scope.

MCI/MPS—Dan presented the outline for the MCI plan and spoke about specific points. Group had discussion and gave support to Dan's efforts. Dan also spoke

about the different triage tags being used and he will present at next meeting the various options. Shawn asked about medical tasks forces.

1. **Regional Recert**—Justin advised he has been very busy, more info to come.

New Business

1. **Advanced Airway**—Dan gave a very informative presentation on King LMA's and advanced airway options.
2. **Convalescent Transfers**—Shawn wanted to know what information departments need on transfers. Items were discussed.

Department Representative Roundtable.

DCSO Dispatch—Procedures 90% written. Laverne is leaving, fire records being turned over to Rick. Unknown injury accidents, dispatch is waiting to get better information before sending Fire/EMS.

Black Butte Ranch Fire—Closed applications for student process. Looking at putting on three. AFG grant came through will be buying new SCBA's and Turnouts. Promotional exam soon, maybe a new firefighter in June.

SCMC—Cathy reported OAR on trauma changing. Three hearings to review (April 20th). Surgeons want to review the mandatory entry criteria. Trauma Conference in Sunriver (April 25-27th), to highlight our region and how well we work together. Please submit photos to Cathy of your area and the geographical challenges you face.

Lapine Fire District—Working on multiple budgets, May will be the next bond measure attempt.

Bend Fire and Rescue—Tom reported their Paramedics are giving 5 Haldol and 2 of Ativan to psych patients. Found that the Haldol lists IM only on the vial and contact has been made with the manufacture and many others that say it may be given IV also. Bids opened on 6 new medics and 1 engine. Braun received the bid on the medics. June 2nd and 3rd for next test. Recruitment video on www.youtube.com ODOT barrier issues.

Crecent Fire—Maybe adding another employee. Barry took the ILS protocols and set them to the new standards. Will distribute accordingly.

Crook County Fire and Rescue—Nada

Zoll—Jon reported that Mike Borkowski is going to be taking over the region for him, he has accepted a position in massachutes, starting this summer.

Warm Springs Fire—Nothing

Redmond Fire and Rescue—Dave reported that the ACLS protocols have changed. The ACLS mirror the AHA guidelines. Asked the group to consider making a Central Oregon set to reflect our needs and wants. Bend requested to use etomidate for pediatrics, no information was found as a contradiction. EZ-IO training is available see Michelle at ALO. Looking like a EMS coordinator position might come available in Redmond as a 40 hour M-F person, more to follow. ALO Bend fixed wing will be at the Redmond Airport station from 1900-0700 until October while their runway is being re-surfaced. They will be using Redmond's backup ambulance during that time for transfers.

COCC—Paula reports that the public safety advisory meeting Monday the 9th at Redmond campus at 0900.

CEMS—CEMS looks like it is done. Insurance is such an issue that it seems like it wont work. Recent rescue with Redmond, working on some training and familiarization with each department. SAR looking at purchasing another ambisled.

Crooked River Ranch Fire—High angle potential is there, getting equipment and training. All bonds have went out for the new station, and sold within one day. Getting ready to build. Hired a new day staff person.
