

ECEMS Meeting Minutes
May 2nd, 2006
Redmond Fire and Rescue Training Room

Meeting called to order by Chair Mooers at 1000hrs

Approval of Previous Minutes: Tom made the motion to accept the April 2006 Meeting minutes as typed, Scott 2nd, motion passed.

Communication Report—None.

Treasures Report—Tom reported a \$50 donation was deposited into Safe Kids. A fee of \$50 was paid. Totals for the joint accounts were, \$17,341.36 (total), \$5,842.79 in ECEMS, \$4034.21 in CISD, and \$7,464.36 in Safe Kids, Chemult has paid dues.

Committee Reports

Education—Mary Raymond has submitted a resignation letter, COCC is looking for a replacement.

Protocols—Agreement was made not to sell protocols to any Oregon agency, and will change bylaws to reflect the agreement. So far no problems have come up with the new trauma protocol. Revised protocols will be sent out via email to each agency.

MCI/MPS—The drill will be held on 5/5 any agency who would like to attend is welcome. All hospitals are on board. Drill will begin around 0800, at the airport. The drill will consist of 50 patients.

Old Business—

1. **Prehospital Transfer Forms**—(Conference call with Benjamin) The forms will be completed by the end of the week. 8,000 on order, ECEMS to pay set up costs. Benjamin will deliver to each agency the ordered quantity when they are ready. Dave made a motion, Tom 2nd to increase the costs of each page to \$.01 cents to recoup the costs of the set up fee. Motion passed, without objection.
2. **Website**—(Conference call with Bob Sjolund) Bob reported that COFIA has the website up and running. A fee of \$5.00 per month will be charged to each group wishing to use the site. There will be no charge to update, and updating can be done as much as the users like. He was unsure about the size of the content that ECEMS could post, but he will investigate and report back. Dusty will submit a copy of the members list to Bob for posting. The group will also look into purchasing a domain name for future use.

New Business

1. **IO Drill**—Dave spoke about a price break on the new IO Drill if a large group orders together. (More than 10 drills w/needles) The company will charge \$100 per drill, and \$100 per needle. Retail costs without the price break is around \$495.00.
2. **Meeting Time Change**—Ken entertained a motion to change the monthly meeting time to 0900. Tom 2nd the motion, and it passed without objection.

LaPine Fire District—Bond measure currently open. Looking to hire 9 if the measure passes. New ambulances will be 6-8 months out. Tenders are in and old ones are for sale. Engine specs are coming soon.

Crook County Fire and Rescue—Jim reported that they are getting killed with transfers from ER to patients home. A discussion followed on the options that other agencies have been using to help remediate the problem.

Sisters/Camp Sherman—New Braun ambulance on order, will be hiring a Training Officer soon.

Bound Tree Medical—Chad reported that the conference will be back next year, and will make small changes, overall it went well. He handed out samples of hand wipes, moping additives and glove samples for agencies to use as a trial.

Warm Springs Fire—No Report.

Bend Fire and Rescue—24/7 is working, able to look up charts, still not HIPPA compliant. Recently applied for the Firefighter Assistance Grant, for 7 new gurneys, looking at ferno and stryker power assists. Will be hiring 9 full time people, and looking for part-time paramedics. Part-time paramedics work 0800-1700 1-2 days a week, on the transfer car. Also looking at segways for events.

Zoll—Special going on for AED's, \$1200 complete package. Zoll is leading the pack on the new AHA changes. Jon also met with unicef and validated the transmission capabilities with Zoll.
