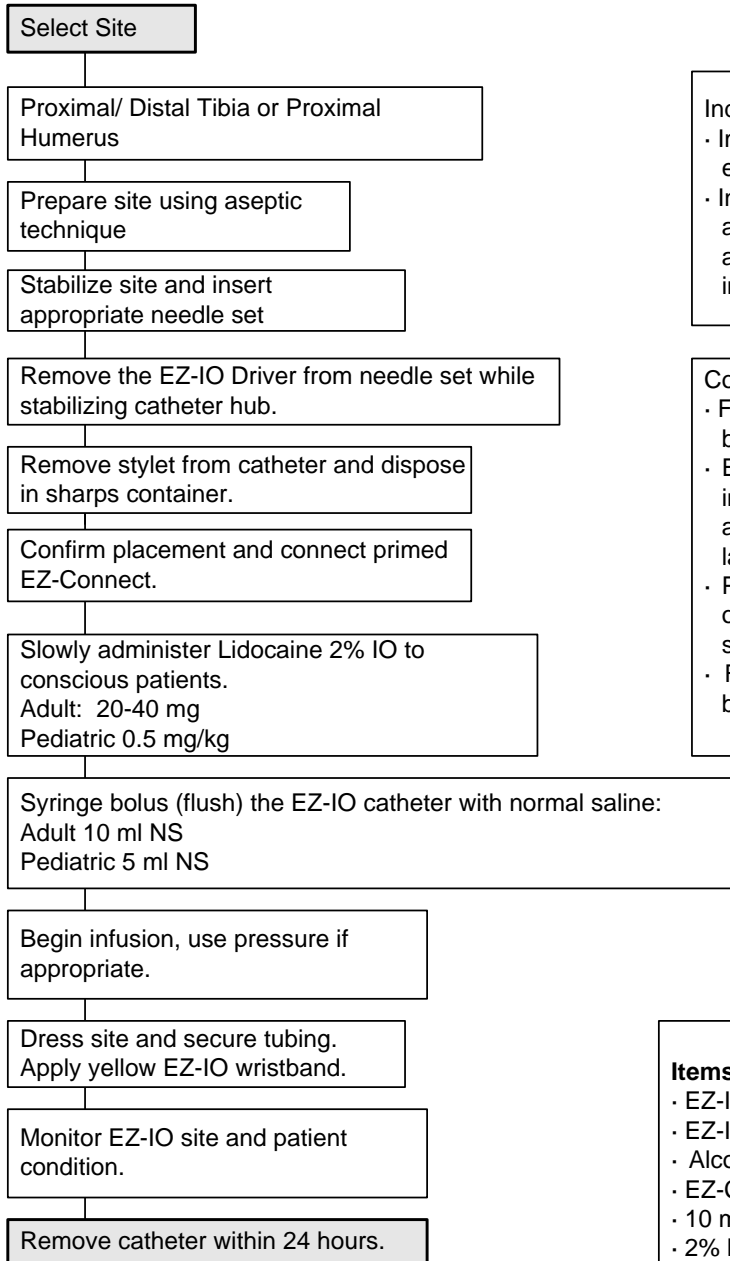


# Intraosseous Infusion EZ-IO

# ALS procedure



**Indications:**

- Immediate vascular access in emergencies
- Inability to establish IV access with two attempts and within 90 seconds in a critical patient

**Contraindications:**

- Fracture of the selected bone.
- Excessive tissue at the insertion site with the absence of anatomical landmarks.
- Previous orthopedic injuries or infection at the selected site.
- Failed IO attempt in same bone.

**Items Needed:**

- EZ-IO Driver
- EZ-IO Needle Set
- Alcohol or Betadine Swab
- EZ-Connect extension Set
- 10 ml syringe with NS
- 2% Lidocaine (preservative free)
- EZ-IO yellow wristband
