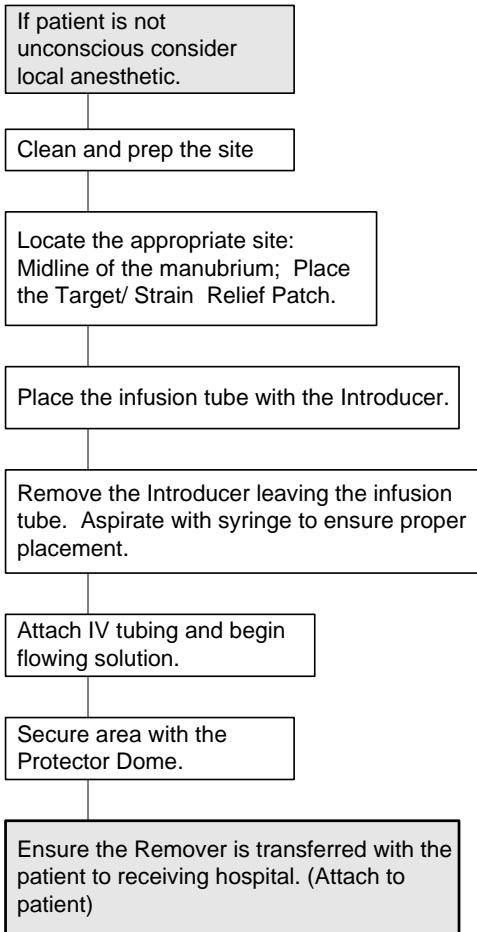


Adult Intraosseous Infusion F.A.S.T.1

ALS procedure




Indications:

- All IV access attempts have failed.
- Circulatory shock, drug overdose, severe hemorrhage, multi-systems trauma, or serious burns.
- Without IO access in critical situations, the alternative may be death.

Items needed:

- Introducer
- Infusion Tube
- Target/ Strain - Relief Patch
- Protector Dome
- Remover
- IV Solution with Tubing
