

Multiple Patient Incident (MPI) Checklist

RESPONDING

- Notify resource hospital of possible MPI, request receiving capabilities
- Request PD for traffic/scene ctrl
- Request ODOT (State Hwys)
- ALO standby (air evacuation)

INITIAL OPERATIONS

- Size-up
- Establish command and identify CP location
- Assign tactical frequency
- Advise dispatch
 - “This is not a drill” (repeat X 2)
 - Location of level 2 staging
- Implement MPI & request
 - Medial task forces
 - Structural task forces (extrication)
 - Hospital receiving capabilities
 - DCSAR (patient evacuation)
 - ALO
- Consider:
 - 304th Air Rescue
 - Life Flight
 - Willamette Valley task forces
- Assign
 - Rescue GS
 - Primary triage
 - EMS Branch Director
 - Staging Area Manager (SAM)
 - Scene Security GS (PD)
- Distribute vests, ID tags, etc.

EXTENDED OPERATIONS

- Extended org. structure (Grps/Div/SO)
- Command staff vest system.
- Communications / Medical plan.
- Air supply / lighting plans.
- Rehabilitation area.
- Food Unit (Salvation Army)
- Displaced citizens (Chaplain/Red Cross).
- Temporary Morgue.
 - Provide for media.

PROGRESS REPORTS

- “All patients extricated”
- “All patients transported”

DEMOBILIZATION

- Demobilize based on assignment and arrival.
- Secure scene (tape off hazard areas)
- Transfer responsibility to investigative authority or owner.

SAFETY

- Consider hazards of underlying incident (MVC, air crash, etc.)
- Require appropriate PPE
- Control traffic
- Control helicopter landing zones
