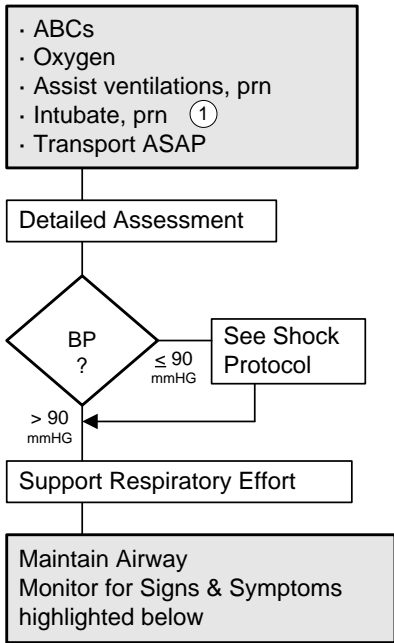



Overdose: Barbiturate

ALS BLS Protocol



Potential Signs & Symptoms of Barbiturate Overdose:
 CNS and respiratory depression, confusion, stupor, coma, ataxia, vertigo, headache, hypotension, cardiovascular collapse, hypothermia, hyperthermia.

-  Document:
- Signs & Symptoms
 - Treatment
 - Clinical Response to Treatment
 - Vital Signs, SpO2
 - Cardiac Rhythm
 - Respiratory Status
 - Glasgow Coma Scale
 - Airway Management
 - Conversations with Medical Control and/or Poison Control
