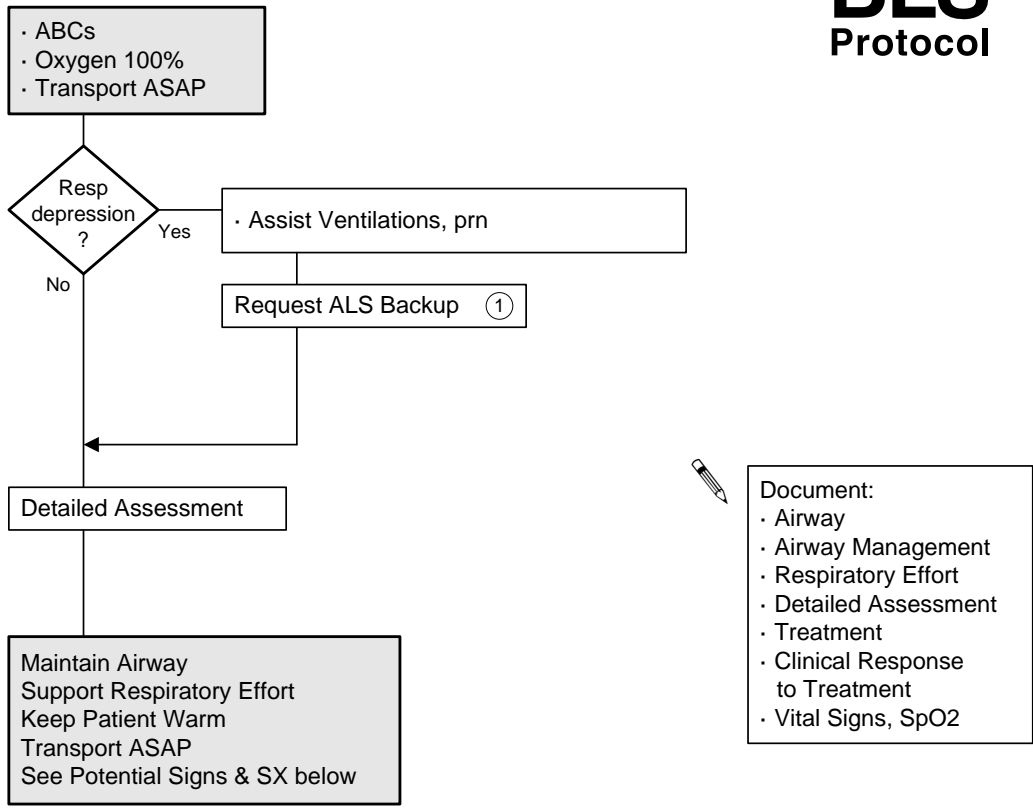


Overdose: Narcotic

BLS Protocol



Potential Signs & Symptoms of Narcotic Overdose:
 CNS & respiratory depression, drowsiness, nausea, vomiting, pinpoint pupils, coma, cyanosis, bradycardia.

| | To Voice | 3 |
| | To Pain | 2 |
| | None | 1 |
| Verbal Response | Oriented | 5 |
| | Confused | 4 |
| | Inappropriate words | 3 |
| | Incomprehensible words | 2 |
| Motor Response | None | 1 |
| | Obeys Commands | 6 |
| | Localizes Pain | 5 |
| | Withdraws (Pain) | 4 |
| | Flexion | 3 |
| | Extension | 2 |
| | None | 1 |

1 ALS Backup should be considered if Narcan is indicated.
