Approval of Previous Minutes: Jim made the motion to accept the August 2007 minutes as typed, Tom 2nd, motion passed.

Communication Report: Dr Eschelbach asked about volunteers for health occupation class with high school students. Tammy Holt (teacher) will call or email members for assistance.

Treasures Report: Tom reported that safe kids will be getting \$7000 for helmets. Also, there is a chance that CISD will be going out on its own, wait and see. Car seat tech. training has been done with more to come. ECEMS account has interest only. Treasures report was approved by Jim and 2nd by Rick, motion passed.

Committee Reports:

Education: Vicky stated that the attendance has risen 2% this year. She states that 165 students in EMS classes this term. Also, the college will try to have a national test at the first of the year, help will be needed. Thanks to all that help with lab assistance. OAR 133 is being worked out, upgrade of EMT. All of Oregon schools are trying to make all classes for EMT Paramedic the same throughout states. Paramedic registration is in spring.

Protocols: The rollout of the new protocols for fentanyl, zofran and the selective c-spine will be delayed until more training can be done. Dr. Eschelbach will talk with other MD about protocols. Also, Dr. Eschelbach talked about the level of readiness of the hospitals and EMS to an MCI involving chemical weapons. It was stated that we need a new protocol for this. As it stands right now, there are changes with the MARK 1 kits and there is new duo-dote kits. We, as a group, need to understand and educate our department up to a working level of how to deal with these emergencies and the process of getting the meds in the field and in the hospitals.

New Business: We need to find a secretary for ECEMS. Tom asked about mileage refund checks to Clear Choice and if anyone else had to deal with that. Also, who will take over the website? Maybe Dan?

Old Business: Question was asked about the protocol for dislocation. It's in the wilderness medicine now only. Question about the King Tube was brought up, need to ask Dan about it.
